उत्तराखण्ड शासन के शासनादेश सं० 712/XXVIII-3-2019-15/2019 दिनांक 27.09.2019 द्वारा उत्तराखण्ड राज्य के राजकीय चिकित्सालयों के उपयोगार्थ औषधियों, सर्जिकल सामग्री, रसायन, चिकित्सकीय उपकरण एवं इम्प्लांट्स के क्रय हेतु नवीन नीति 2019 प्रख्यापित की गयी है। जिसके अनुपालन में Essential Drug List 2019 तैयार की गयी।

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उपकेन्द्र व प्राथमिक स्वास्थ्य केन्द्रों में औषधि निकटतम सी0एच0सी0 से वितरित की जाती है, जिसमें औषधि प्राप्त कर केन्द्र पर लाने में राजकीय वाहन उपलब्ध न होने की दशा में अपनी व्यवस्था करनी पड़ती है जिससे व्ययभार पड़ता है। बैठक में उक्त सम्बंध में चर्चा की गयी। वित्त विभाग द्वारा अवगत कराया गया कि औषधियों के गंतव्य पर परिवहन (transportation) हेतु मुख्य चिकित्सा अधिकारी द्वारा महानिदेशालय स्तर पर आवश्यक धनराशि की मांग की जा सकती है, मानक मद 42-अन्य व्यय के अंतर्गत उपलब्ध धनराशि के सापेक्ष मांग के अनुसार धनराशि सम्बंधित मुख्य चिकित्सा अधिकारी को उपलब्ध करायी जा सकती है।

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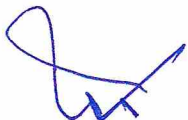
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
